House Bill 0001 – Prohibit Recognition and Alliance with Micronations Displaying Hateful, Offensive Images and Conduct

Summary:

The Department of Foreign Affairs during research of other Micronations, has observed several Micronations “following” or attempting to ally with Dracul on Facebook and Instagram, not only displaying, but promoting highly offensive content. Content included, but was not limited to: Swastikas, Hammer and Sickles, statements of Antisemitism, Anti-LGBT, such as violence and hatred, Racism, and violence promoted against previously stated groups. Authorizing recognition or alliances with these types of micronations would cause severe damage to Dracul’s image and question Dracul’s mission for promoting peace and freedom.

Proposal:

All Commonwealth of Dracul Social Media Accounts must:

1. Prohibit offensive micronations from contacting Dracul’s Foreign Affairs Department
2. Block all offensive micronations with social media from gaining access to Dracul’s accounts
3. Terminate any alliance or recognition with micronations discovered promoting offensive content
